A Call-to-Action for Global Warming Solutions in Maryland ***NUMBER concerned citizens to gather in PLACE for a "Town Hall" meeting to discuss impacts, solutions to global warming in Md.***

The forum is part of a state-wide month of action to highlight global warming.

Governor O'Malley has created a Commission on Climate Change to determine what actions Maryland should take to address global warming. The commission will recommend a target pollution reduction level in November. The *PLACE* town hall meeting is part of dozens of events taking place across Maryland that month to highlight the impacts of global warming on Maryland and the support for a strong commitment to reducing global warming pollution.
